



Michaels, David BC-1230

While in the heart of Taliban-controlled Afghanistan to take down terrorist leader Mullah Mohammed Zahed, Captain Scott Mitchell and his Ghost Recon team must navigate through a minefield of carnage and politics to accomplish their mission.




