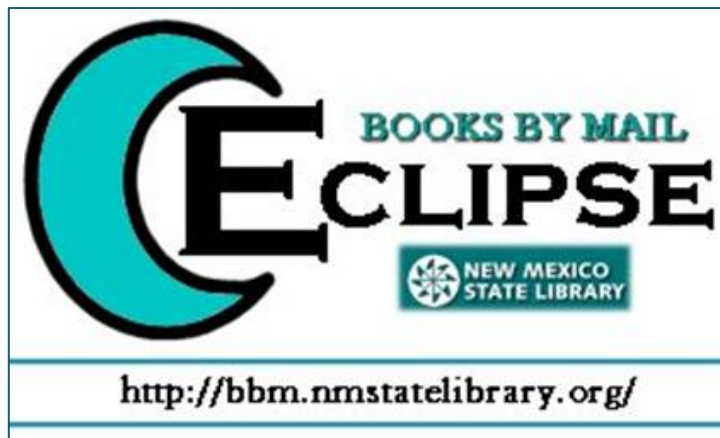

LARGE PRINT. A young man seeks wisdom from a retired hunter who explains how the principles of bow hunting can help readers find the courage to take risks and embrace life's unexpected turns.

LARGE PRINT. Working as an organic farmer in a post-apocalypse world devoid of technology, a former Los Angeles screenwriter unexpectedly reconnects with his once-famous partner, who has retrofitted a nuclear-powered digger to launch an unknown agenda.

Maguire, Gregory **LP-5752**

LARGE PRINT. Following her brother's death and her mother's emotional breakdown, Laura now lives on the Upper East Side of Manhattan, in a lonely townhouse she shares with her old-world, strict, often querulous grandparents. But the arrangement may be temporary. The quiet, awkward teenager has been getting into trouble at home and has been expelled from her high school for throwing a record album at a popular girl who bullied her. When Christmas is over and the new year begins, Laura may find herself at boarding school in Montreal.

FIC 🌸 Cold case pursuit

Mentink, Dana **LP-5799**

LARGE PRINT. Decades after her parents' murders, Penelope McGregor's grateful the killer's finally been identified, until he comes after her. Now Detective Tyler Walker and his K-9 partner, Dusty, must protect Penelope and catch the culprit, while making sure his little girl stays out of the crosshairs. But can the single father outplay a killer whose endgame will leave no one safe?

FIC 🌸 Forever by your side

Peterson, Tracie **LP-5780**

LARGE PRINT. Accompanied by her best friend, Thomas Lowell, Constance Browning returns from studying in the East to catalog the native peoples of Oregon, and to prove that her missionary parents aren't involved in a secret conspiracy to goad the oppressed tribes to war. As tensions rise amid shocking revelations, Constance may also have a revelation of the heart.

LARGE PRINT. It was a typical evening at a mall outside Portland, Maine, until the shooting began. For eight minutes the chaos spread, eight minutes that transformed the lives of everyone in its wake. Some had their futures stolen from them, while others would discover their true calling. But for one person, it would be the start of a far more calculated plan, one that would force the survivors to face an even greater test in the years to come.

FIC ✨ **My dark Vanessa: a novel**

LARGE PRINT. Bright, ambitious, and yearning for adulthood, fifteen-year-old Vanessa Wye becomes entangled in an affair with Jacob Strane, her magnetic and guileful forty-two-year-old English teacher. 2017. Amid the rising wave of allegations against powerful men, a reckoning is coming due. Strane has been accused of sexual abuse by a former student, who reaches out to Vanessa, and now Vanessa suddenly finds herself facing an impossible choice: remain silent, firm in the belief that her teenage self willingly engaged in this relationship, or redefine herself and the events of her past.

FIC ✨ **The forever girl**

Shalvis, Jill **LP-5767**

LARGE PRINT. When Maze returns to Wildstone for the wedding of her estranged bff and the sister of her heart, it's also a reunion of a once ragtag team of teenagers who had only each other until a tragedy tore them apart and scattered them wide. Now as adults together again in the lake house, there are secrets and resentments mixed up in all the amazing childhood memories. Unexpectedly, they instantly fall back into their roles: Maze their reckless leader, Cat the den mother, Heather the beloved baby sister, and Walker, a man of mystery.

FIC ✨ **Neighbors**

Steel, Danielle **LP-5773**

LARGE PRINT. Opening her home to neighbors in the aftermath of a devastating earthquake, a reclusive woman inadvertently triggers events that reveal

secrets, divide relationships and forge new bonds among strangers.

FIC ✨ **The cold millions**

Walter, Jess **LP-5776**

LARGE PRINT. Enduring the corruption of their union employment, two young day laborers are respectively drawn to a feminist activist and a vaudeville singer whose experiences reflect an unjust world on the brink of upheaval.

HISTORICAL FICTION

HIF ✨ **Indiscretions along virtue avenue: confessions of Sadie Orchard**

Courtland, Harper **LP-5787**

LARGE PRINT. This highly researched novel follows the life of Sadie Orchard, a real historical character, born Sarah Jane Creech in Mills County, Iowa, in 1859. A prostitute, Sadie moved into Kingston, New Mexico Territory, in 1886, claiming to be from London. Within a year, she had her own brothel on Virtue Avenue. Outrageous stories abound about Sadie, but some find it plausible that she employed dynamite in an attempted murder. Harper Courtland blends the myths with known details of Sadie's life, adds an element of the supernatural, and lets Sadie fill in the rest.

HIF ✨ **The exiles**

Kline, Christina Baker **LP-5771**

LARGE PRINT. Sent to a Tasmanian penal colony after conceiving her employer's grandchild, a young governess befriends a talented midwife and an orphaned Aboriginal chief's daughter while confronting the harsh realities of British colonialism and oppression in 19th-century Australia.

HISTORY

HIS ✨ **Agent Sonya: Moscow's most daring wartime spy**

Macintyre, Ben **LP-5758**

LARGE PRINT. In 1942, in a quiet village in the leafy English Cotswolds, a thin, elegant woman lived in a small cottage with her three children and her husband, who worked as a machinist nearby. Ursula Burton was friendly but reserved, and spoke English with a slight foreign accent. By all accounts, she seemed to be living a simple, unassuming life. Her neighbors in the village knew little about her. They didn't know that she was a high-ranking Soviet intelligence officer. They didn't know that her husband was also a spy, or that she was running powerful agents across Europe. Behind the façade, she was a dedicated Communist, a Soviet colonel, and a veteran agent, gathering secrets that would enable the Soviet Union to build the bomb.

LARGE PRINT. In the middle of the night, in a house in suburban Minneapolis, intruders murder Luke Ellis's parents and load him into a black SUV. Luke will wake up at The Institute, in a room that looks just like his own, except there's no window. Other kids with special talents, telekinesis and telepathy, are also here. Some, like Luke, are in Front Half, while others graduated to Back Half. In this most sinister of institutions, the director and her staff attempt to extract from these children the force of their extra-normal gifts. As each

new victim disappears to Back Half, Luke becomes desperate to get out and get help. But no one has ever escaped from the Institute.

MYS ✨ **The book of candlelight**

Adams, Ellery **LP-5788**

LARGE PRINT. The owner of a local book store finds an old diary that somehow holds a clue to several recent, suspicious deaths in her small town.

MYS ✨ **And then they were doomed**

Buzzelli, Elizabeth Kane **LP-5754**

LARGE PRINT. Little Person author Zoe Zola receives an invitation to an Agatha Christie symposium at an old hunting lodge. Zoe and nine other Christie scholars arrive at the lodge. Next morning, the guests find one particularly odious man has gone, whereabouts unknown. As the guests disappear, one by one, Zoe will have to draw on everything she knows about Agatha Christie's devilish plots to solve the mystery.

MYS ✨ **Kiss the girls and make them cry**

Clark, Mary Higgins **LP-5781**

LARGE PRINT. When investigative journalist Gina Kane receives an email from a 'CRyan' describing her 'terrible experience' while working at REL, a high-profile television news network, including the comment 'and I'm not the only one,' Gina knows she has to pursue the story. But when Ryan goes silent, Gina is shocked to discover the young woman has died tragically in a jet ski accident while on holiday.

MYS ✿ Fatal roots

Connolly, Sheila **LP-5779**

LARGE PRINT. Informed by Cork University students that her inherited property is believed to be the home of a mystical fairy fort, Boston expat Maura Donovan disregards local superstitions before a student's disappearance leads to a shocking discovery.

MYS ✿ Here comes the body

Dirico, Maria **LP-5782**

LARGE PRINT. Mia Carina is starting work at her father's catering hall. Soon she's planning a bachelor party for a less-than-gentlemanly groom and when the gigantic cake is wheeled in, a deadly surprise is revealed. Since some of her family's associates are on the shady side, the NYPD wastes no time in casting suspicion on Mia's father. Now, Mia has to use all her street smarts to keep him out of Rikers Island.

MYS ✿ Murder cuts the mustard

Ellicott, Jessica **LP-5789**

LARGE PRINT. Proper Brit Edwina Davenport and brash American Beryl Helliwell investigate the murder of an elderly gardener's brother-in-law in the quaint post-World War I village of Walmsley Parva, discovering a valuable ring and a second homicide along the way.

MYS ✿ Careless whiskers

James, Miranda **LP-5755**

LARGE PRINT. When his lead-actress daughter is wrongly accused of poisoning a fading, drama-prone actor during a local stage production, Charlie teams up with

feline sidekick, Diesel, to identify the true killer.

MYS ✿ Missing and endangered

Jance, J. A. **LP-5792**

LARGE PRINT. Protecting a brilliant freshman whose home-schooled life has left her unprepared for the outside world, Jennifer invites the vulnerable girl home for a Christmas break that embroils Sheriff Joanna Brady in a volatile missing-persons case.

MYS ✿ The kingdom

Nesbo, Jo **LP-5774**

LARGE PRINT. A mechanic from a rural mountain village finds the limits of his family loyalties tested when his entrepreneur brother announces plans to revitalize the community through a hotel project that becomes increasingly overshadowed by greed and dangerous secrets.

MYS ✿ Sealed off

Ross, Barbara **LP-5784**

LARGE PRINT. Julia Snowden is doing a renovation of the old mansion on Morrow Island. When the demo team discovers a room that's been sealed off for decades, Julia's curious as to what secrets it might have held. Tensions are already simmering with the crew, but when one of the workers is found murdered, things come to a boil. With the discovery of another body, and a mysterious diary, the pressure's on Julia to dig up a real killer fast.

LARGE PRINT. Terri Rayburn is a girl with a reputation. She doesn't deserve it but, having grown up on the outskirts of Summer Hill, she knows how small towns work. The only way to deal with vicious gossip is to ignore it. So she keeps to herself as she runs the summer resort on Lake Kissel. When she returns home from a short trip to find a handsome stranger living in her house, she smells a rat. Someone is trying to fix her up, and she has to admit that Nate Taggart is just her type. However, Nate is engaged to the daughter of the mayor and strictly off-limits.

ROM ✨ **Immortal angel**

Sands, Lynsay **LP-5772**

LARGE PRINT. Forced to relocate when her vigilante tendencies lead to unwanted trouble, Ildaria captures the attentions of an enamored club owner, G.G., who navigates apprehensions about their differences before he is challenged to confront his personal demons.

ROM ✨ **All that glitters**

Steel, Danielle **LP-5760**

LARGE PRINT. When her life of privilege is upended by a terrorist attack that ends her parents' lives, a college senior struggles to rebuild on her own terms, learning uplifting and heartbreaking life lessons throughout a series of relationships and opportunities.

SCIENCE FICTION

SFF ✨ **Ready player two**

Cline, Ernest **LP-5762**

LARGE PRINT. A 1980s cultural assessment of the fantastical future of online behavior continues the story that began in the internationally best-selling futuristic novel. (Book 1, (LP-5048)).

SUSPENSE

SUS ✨ **The bitterroots**

Box, C. J. **LP-5798**

LARGE PRINT. Former police officer Cassie Dewell is trying to start over with her own private investigation firm. Guilty about not seeing her son and exhausted by the nights on stakeout, Cassie is nonetheless managing, until an old friend calls in a favor: she wants Cassie to help exonerate a man accused of assaulting a young girl from an influential family. Against her own better judgment, Cassie agrees.

SUS ✨ **Tom Clancy shadow of the dragon**

Cameron, Marc **LP-5768**

LARGE PRINT. When a high-level mole infiltrates American Intelligence, President Jack Ryan dispatches John Clark and the Campus team to track down a missing scientist who holds critical aerospace and navel technology.

SUS ✿ The sentinel

Child, Lee **LP-5761**

LARGE PRINT. Jack Reacher follows his lizard-brain instincts on a seemingly uneventful night in Nashville, where a recently fired man nurses an increasingly violent grudge.

SUS ✿ Death and the maiden

Franklin, Ariana **LP-5757**

LARGE PRINT. A long-anticipated series conclusion finds a young healer dispatched to the Cambridgeshire village of Ely, where her courtship with a young aristocrat is complicated by her investigation into the disappearances of several local girls.

SUS ✿ House of correction

French, Nicci **LP-5766**

LARGE PRINT. Attempting to solve her own case from the confines of prison, a reclusive murder suspect from an English village uncovers evidence that calls her own sanity into question.

SUS ✿ Losing you: a novel

French, Nicci **LP-5770**

LARGE PRINT. It's Nina Landry's birthday, and she's supposed to have her kids ready to leave in a few hours for a Christmas holiday in Florida with her new boyfriend, but her fifteen-year-old daughter Charlie spent the night at a friend's and hasn't come home yet. Not by ten a.m., not by eleven. Nina is getting angry, they have a plane to catch, and Charlie hasn't even bothered to pack. As time passes, though slower and slower by the minute, Nina becomes uneasy. Her

League coach, English teacher, husband, and father of two girls. Detective Ralph Anderson, whose son Maitland once coached, orders a quick and very public arrest. 1. **If you are accessing our catalog online, or getting the emailed PDF file, and no longer need the printed version, please let us know so we can update our files and conserve on mailing costs.**
2. If you have several mailing bags with only a few books in each, coming back to us, you can put all books and any extra bags into the bigger bag and mail to us. This will save on postage.
3. Please do not send empty mailing bags through the mail as each one is a minimum charge of \$2.87 per bag. This will also save on postage. If you just have a slip of paper with your order in the bag, we suggest calling us toll free or email us to place your order.
4. **Please put your name or ID#** on the white order sheets when sending them back to us with your books. These sheets can get mixed up with other orders when we are emptying bags and if there is no name, it is hard to match up the order with the books. If there is a name on it, you are sure to get your order.

You can search the catalog and send your order through our cart and it comes to us.
