

Library Rules and Reminders

- The loan period is 6 weeks after checkout. Please contact our library to extend the loan period <u>before the book is due</u> since books with a waitlist are unable to be extended.
- Patrons are allowed a maximum of 10 books at a time. Books ordered after the allowance has been met will be placed on hold for you and be sent as your other books are checked in.
- Books that are not available at the time of request are automatically put on hold for you and will be sent when they become available. Do not place multiple holds on one book as this can result in having the same title sent to you more than once.
- While the library does not charge for overdue books, you are asked to communicate with the library on the status of those books so that they can be renewed, otherwise your allowed checkouts will decrease or your account may be suspended if overdues without explanation happen repeatedly.
- Please do not send empty mail bags or bags with just your order form back to the library. This also includes the red or purple Free Matter mail bags. The library pays a fee for every empty bag so please return them with your next order in the larger bag.
- Feel free to submit an order however is convenient for you. The voicemail, email, and online system are happy to collect your requests until the library is able to place orders or make adjustments.
- If you move, have a new number, or want to cancel services please contact the library so that your record is updated.
- If you are certified to receive Free Matter mail and request standard print books, they
 will be sent in a paid for mail bag separately from any large print titles you order since
 they do not qualify as Free Matter. There is still no charge to you and our library does
 not want to lose this privilege, so please bear in mind that large print books are the only
 items that may be placed in the red or purple free matter bags.
- Large print books have a call number beginning with LP.
- Request any and all books! I'm always happy to search for it and get it through another library or try to purchase. If you want to read it, then someone else may want to as well.

Scout's reminded of what Atticus taught her as he defends Tom against false allegations. In autumn of 1941, Pecola's life changes in painful devastating ways. <u>Reasons</u>: Depicted child sexual abuse, sexually explicit, containing controversial issues, unsuited for age group, offensive language

LP-5137 The Handmaid's Tale by Margaret Atwood (Large Print)

Women have become Handmaids, are no longer allowed to read, and are only valued if their ovaries are viable. <u>Reasons</u>: Profanity and for vulgarity and sexual overtones.

BB-0840 The Catcher in the Rye by JD Salinger

Holden passes through the city determined to escape the phonies and find a life of true meaning. <u>Reasons</u>: Offensive language, sexually explicit, unsuited to age group.

Adventures of Huckleberry Finn by Mark Twain BB-0835 Standard Print LP-2134 Large Print A story about a young boy and his journey down the Mississippi. <u>Reasons</u>: offensive language, racism

BB-0894 Of Mice and Men by John Steinbeck

George and Lennie have plans, but Lennie's unswerving obedience has consequences. <u>Reasons</u>: Racial slurs and stereotypes, negative effects on students, offensive language, violence.

You will be entertained, informed, and you will know that however you identify (or don't,) you are exceptional. You matter. Reasons: provided sexual education, LGBTQIA+

CE-1034 Nickel and Dimed: On (Not) Getting By in America by Barbra Ehrenreich

An investigative work into low rent America and a thousand desperate stratagems for survival. Reasons: drugs, inaccurate, offensive language, political viewpoint, religious viewpoint.

Stamped: Racism, Antiracism and You by Ibram X. Kendi and Jason Reynolds CE-1029 Standard Print **CE-1030 Spanish Edition**



CE-1031 Stamped (For Kids)

Shows how racist ideas started and spread, and how to discredit them./ Este libro muestra cómo comenzaron y se difundieron las ideas racistas y cómo desacreditarlas.

Reasons: claims it contains "selective storytelling incidents" and does not encompass racism against all people, author's public statements

CE-1067 It's Perfectly Normal: Changing Bodies, Growing Up, Sex, Gender, Sexual Health by Robie H. Harris and Michael Emberley

Information to answer questions and concerns about puberty, sex, gender, sexual health, reproduction, birth control, pregnancy, birth, families, LGBTQIA+, social media, the internet, sexual abuse, and STDs. Reasons: Provides sex education, sexually explicit, abortion, homosexuality, nudity, religious viewpoint, unsuited to age group, alleges it is "child pornography."

Religious Books

CE-1035 The Holy Bible: King James Version CE-1036 The Holy Bible: New King James Version

Collection of religious texts or scriptures that are held sacred in many religions.

Memoirs and Biographies

CE-1026 I Know Why the Caged Bird Sings by Maya Angelou

A coming-of-age story that illustrates how strength of character and a love of literature can help overcome racism and trauma. Reasons: Sexually explicit, homosexuality, offensive language, racism, violence, unsuited to age group.

CE-1027 Beyond Magenta: Transgender Teens Speak Out by Susan Kuklin

Six real stories from members of the trans and nonbinary community about their experiences. Reasons: LGBTQIA+ content, sexually explicit

CE-1032 Fun Home: A Family Tragicomic by Alison Bechdel

Bechdel charts her fraught relationship with her late father. Reasons: Violence and other graphic images

CE-1033 Persepolis by Marjane Strapi Satrapi tells the story of her life in Tehran, the years that she saw the overthrow of the Shah's regime, the Islamic Revolution, and the devastating effects of war with Iraq. Reasons: Gambling, Offensive language, political viewpoint. Politically, racially, and socially offensive. Graphic depictions.

CE-1064 Gender Queer by Maia Kobabe

Tells of Mais's path to identifying as nonbinary and asexual and coming out to eir family and society. Reasons: LGBTQIA+, Sexually explicit images

The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night Time by Mark Haddon CE-1038 Standard Print CE-1039 Spanish Edition

Christopher decides he will track down the real killer of the neighbor's dog and turns to his favorite fictional character for inspiration. Greg wants to keep a low profile his senior year plan until his mom forces him to become friends with a girl who has cancer. <u>Reasons:</u> sexually explicit, degrading to women








CENSORSHIP ON THE RISE

- 2 medium yellow onions, halved and thinly sliced
- 2 tablespoons coarsely • chopped fresh rosemary (or 2 teaspoons dried rosemary)
- 2 tablespoons maple syrup
- 4 garlic cloves, coarsely chopped
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup fresh apple cider (or $\frac{3}{4}$ cup apple juice)
- 4 cups low-sodium chicken broth, plus more as needed
- 2 (15-ounce) cans pumpkin purée (not pumpkin pie filling), or 3 cups homemade pumpkin purée
- 1 teaspoon mild curry powder •
- $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon ground nutmeg, plus more for serving
- Pinch of ground cloves
- 1¹/₂ teaspoons kosher salt, plus more as needed
- ¹/₂ teaspoon black pepper, plus more as needed
- ¹∕₃ cup heavy cream, plus more for serving

Fried Sage Topping (Optional)

- 2 tablespoons unsalted butter
- 12 fresh sage leaves

Preparation:

- 1.In a large Dutch oven or other heavy-bottomed pot, melt butter over medium heat. Add onions and rosemary and cook, stirring occasionally, until the onions are lightly caramelized, about 15-20 minutes. Lower the heat if the onions brown too guickly.
- 2.Add the maple syrup and garlic, stirring occasionally, until the onions have darkened in color, 3-5 minutes. Add the cider or juice and cook, scraping up any bits from the bottom of the pan, until the liquid is reduced by about half.
- 3.Add the broth, pumpkin puree, and spices. Stir to combine and bring to a boil. Turn the heat to mediumlow and cook at full simmer for 10 minutes, stirring occasionally and scraping the bottom of the pot to prevent scorching.
- 4. Working in batches, puree the soup in a blender or food processor and return to the pot (or use an immersion blender). Bring back to a simmer over medium heat, then turn off the heat and stir in the cream. Season with salt and pepper to taste. Add more broth if soup is too thick.

Fried Sage Topping

Melt the butter in a small/medium size skillet over medium-high heat. Add sage leaves and fry until just crisp, 1-2 minutes. Using a slotted spoon or fork, transfer the sage leaves to a paper towel-lined plate. Use any remaining butter to top servings with a swirl of cream and pinch of nutmeq.



Librarian's tips/substitutions: Fry diced bacon, then cook the onions and rosemary in bacon fat. Top the soup with bacon, goat cheese crumbles and roasted pumpkin seeds!
